

Shannonville Track Day Rules

(We run rain or shine. Please bring your rain tires. However, if you decide to take a rain check for one of the next events, you are welcome to, and there is no charge).

1. Everyone is responsible for knowing all the rules and regulations set out by SMP for lapping / track days.
2. Each motorcycle must pass the mandatory tech inspection before being allowed to participate in RACE test days but not for motorcycle lapping days. However, it might be done at any time on a spot check basis.
3. Riders meetings take place at 8:30 a.m. and are mandatory.
4. Each motorcycle must be in good mechanical condition, including brakes, tires and free from any fluid leaks.
5. Side mirrors must be removed.
6. Turn signals, the headlights, taillights and any plastic lense covers must be taped over with masking tap or painters tape. (Duct tape is not recommended) A working headlight or taillight must not be visible through the tape or the required fuse and connection must be removed as well.
7. A properly working front and rear brake is required. Bikes are allowed to have a sidestand, but should be tied or locked in the upward position at all times.
8. An easily accessible operational kill switch, and self returning throttle are required.
9. Oil drain plugs and bolts that hold fluids in reserve should be drilled and lock wired and free of leaks. Antifreeze is not permitted. (distilled water and water wetter is allowed).
10. All riding gear must be in good condition and free from excessive damage or wear.
11. Riders are required to have a full faced motorcycle helmet intended for this type of riding activity. It must have at least a Snell 2010 rating or the equivalent European rating.
12. Full riding leathers in good condition are required, either 1-piece or 2-piece. If 2-piece leathers are used, the upper & lower parts must be zipped together with a full circumference zipper. Leather gloves and boots (that go above the ankle) are required. Plastic, Kevlar, or nylon riding apparel is not permitted.
13. Alcohol is permitted only at the end of the day when all track activities are concluded by everyone. Anyone consuming illegal drugs will be required to leave (with a police escort).
14. Any type of in-appropriate activites on or off the track will result in the riders being forced to leave. (without a refund)
15. SMP reserves the right to apply rules that may not be listed above and to impose the appropriate action.
16. All participants are required to act appropriately at all times.
17. These rules apply to Shannonville track day customers and differ from the rule book of RACE licence holders.
