

Shannonville Track Day Rules

1. Everyone is responsible for knowing all the rules and regulations set out by SMP for lapping / track days.
2. Each motorcycle must pass the mandatory tech inspection before being allowed to participate in any track activities.
3. Riders meetings take place at 8:30 a.m. and are Mandatory for all riders.
4. Each motorcycle must be in good mechanical condition, including brakes, tires and free from any fluid leaks.
5. The side mirrors have to be removed.
6. Turn signals, the headlights, taillights and any plastic lense covers must be taped over with masking tap or painters tape. (Duct tape is not recommended) A working headlight or taillight must not be visible through the tape or the required fuse and connection must be removed as well.
7. A properly working front and rear brake is required. Bikes are allowed to have a sidestand, but should be tied or locked in the upward position at all times.
8. An easily accessible kill switch, and self returning throttle are required.
9. A clear visible set of bike numbers are required on either side of the bike. And must be recorded at time of registration.
10. Oil drain plugs and bolts that hold fluids in reserve should be drilled and lock wired and free of signs of leaks. Antifreeze is not permitted. (water wetter is allowed).
11. All riding gear must be in good condition and free from excessive damage.
12. Riders are required to have a full faced motorcycle helmet intended for this type of riding activity. It must have at least a Snell 2000 rating or the equivalent European rating.
13. Full leathers are required, one or two piece that zip together and must be in good condition. Leather gloves and boots (that go above the ankle) are necessary. Plastic, Kevlar or nylon riding apparel is not permitted.
14. Alcohol is only permitted at the end of the day when are track activites are concluded by everyone. Anyone consuming illegal drugs will be required to leave (with a police escort)
15. Any type of in-appropriate activites on or off the track will result in the riders being forced to leave. (without a refund)
16. SMP reserves the right to apply rules that may not be listed above and to impose the required action.
17. All participants are required to act accordingly at all times.
